Hearing God's Voice Through Worship

Chapter 4

Hebrews 10:25 Let's see how inventive we can be with encouraging love and helping out, not avoiding worshipping together as some do but spurring each other on, especially as we see the big Day approaching. The MSC.

Question: How does faithfulness to the church encourage others and move them to love and do good works?

Read Exodus 25:22 God wants to meet with you and talk with you.

Question: Have you ever thought about how these two actions are closely related to each other, but they don't always happen at the same time?

Read 2 Corinthians 6:16 and Ephesians 3:17

Question: What is the difference of God meeting His people at the tabernacle and how He meets with us in our hearts?

Read Psalm 16:11 and Acts 3:19

Question: How do we experience joy, feeling refreshed, and perspective in doing worship with the Lord?

Read Psalm 103:12 With our sins taken care of, restoration and fellowship happen in God's presence.

Question: When our hearts have been washed clean, how does this help us enter into worship with the Lord?

Read Psalm 73:1-17 Asaph writes about his struggles and doubts.

Question: We do the same thing with our doubts and our struggles in life, but how do our hearts change like Asaph in verse 1? When we get back into His sanctuary?

In closing: We can often hear God's voice more clearly in worship. If you are wanting to hear from the Lord, enter a time of worship. Quiet your heart and focus on the Lord.
