



## Frequency - Tune In. Hear God

Chapter 9 – Hear God’s Voice for Others

How have the past 8 sessions encouraged you in hearing God’s Voice? Give examples in what ways.

**1 Corinthians 14:1 Pursue love, and desire spiritual gifts, but especially that you may prophesy.**

Share a story of an experience in which you heard God’s Voice to share or give a word from the Lord.

**Read: Matthew 7:15, 2 Corinthians 11:13-14**

Question: Why is it important to discern from what a spoken word is given, and know from scripture it is accurate?

The Greek word for prophet is “prophetes”. It means “God’s spokesman” or “Someone who speaks”.

**Read: 1 Corinthians 14:29**

Question: Can you give an example of someone who today is looked at as a prophet? Do you believe it to be true? Give examples of false prophets today.

**Read 1 Corinthians 14:3**

Question: Prophecy is meant to encourage others. Give an example of someone who has given you a word of encouragement.

Question: Can you give examples of times you thought to call someone, send them a note or text an encouraging word to them, but didn’t because you were simply afraid to?

Prophecy is never to be manipulative or used for selfish gain. It’s another confirmation that God is at work in our midst.
