Read 2 Samuel 23:8

Question: Josheb has this one encounter in which he gave all of himself. How would you describe “give your all” to something you believe in?

Courage: Mental or moral strength to venture, persevere, and withstand danger, fear, or difficulty.

Question: How can we live a life in which courage is part of our everyday lives?

Read Joshua 2:1-16

In this portion of scripture Rahab saved the lives of the spies by risking her own life.

Question: What ripple effect by showing kindness to the spies also changed the course of Israel and a future king to the King of Kings? What ripple effect are you showing in living a life of kindness?

Question: What is your life verse? How does it define who you are in Christ and your way of life?
