Week 5, Chapters 9 & 10

Read 2 Samuel 23:13-17

The cave of Adullam was a dark place at a difficult time of David. But that is where trust was tempered and faith was forged. That is where David discovered what it meant to give God the sacrifice of praise.

Question: Describe that dark place in which you learned your trust was tempered and your faith was forged.

The cave of Adullam wasn't where David wanted to be, but it is where David needed to be for a season.

Question: Give a time in your life in which it was a season in your own life that you didn't want to be in, but it was necessary as you look back on it.

Read 1 Samuel 24:1-22

Question: David forfeited what seemed like a golden opportunity to preserve his integrity. Why?

Opportunity isn't an opportunity if you have to compromise integrity. It's the decision when no one is looking that will dictate your destiny.

Question: How does integrity become your destiny?

We live in a culture that idolizes success and demonizes failure. But in God's Kingdom the outcome isn't the issue. Success isn't winning or losing; it's obeying.

Question: Give examples in which you praised God no matter what the outcome?
