Chapters 15 & 16

Read Jeremiah 1:4-10

Jeremiah was called into ministry at 20-25 years of age. All men have been formed by God for a purpose in life.

Question: At what age did you realize the call to what you do in life at this time? How are you living out your mission field?

Just because something isn't part of your life plan, it doesn't mean it's not part of God's plan.

Question: Give an example of a situation or an experience in life that didn't make sense, yet it was part of God's plan.

Our Founding Fathers of our nation had more influence in death than in life. It's also true with spiritual fathers.

Question: What legacy was handed down to you from a grandparent or someone who has now passed in this life?

Benaiah wasn't called to be famous but to make David famous. It wasn't about Benaiah.

Question: How are you realizing that life isn't all about you, but that it's to make Jesus our Lord famous?

In the realm of mathematics, there are two types of progression: linear and exponential. Linear progression is two plus two = four. Exponential progression is compound doubling. Four times four = sixteen. Faith isn't linear. Faith is exponential.

Question: Every decision we make or risk has a chain reaction. How is faith being exponential being experienced or planned in your life?
