Chapters 17 & 18

Read 1 Samuel 22:1-5

Men united by adverse circumstances became David's army.

Question: Out of the original 400 came the mighty of David. Why is it important to include all men to advance God's kingdom? What has this taught you in life?

When a friend like Eleazar fights until his fist freezes to his sword, all excuses go out the window. It pushes you to push yourself.

Question: Who is pushing you? What man in your life pushes you in the fight of life and in the faith?

Read Proverbs 27:17. Two edges of steel rubbing sharpens both blades together.

Question: Men need fellowship with men. How has meeting as Vital Men encouraged you?

Read Hebrews 4:12. The Word of God is a double-edged sword.

Question: How has the tool of a blade used as a tool of judgement and execution for those who have not committed themselves to Christ?

Read Matthew 18:20 and Malachi 3:16

Question: There is a promise of a blessing that two who meet in the Lord's name will receive a blessing. How have you experienced that?

Read Psalm 133:1

Question: How has uniting and living in harmony with other Christian men made you a better man of God?

Final thought: True greatness isn't measured by your accomplishments. The true test of greatness is measured by the accomplishments of those you surround yourself with, those who come after you.
